





# CONTINUOUS PROFESSIONAL LEARNING TIP SHEET

## B. Knowledge

RECEs:

1. Are knowledgeable about the research and theories related to the impact of caring and responsive relationships on children's development, learning, self-regulation, identity and well-being.
2. Are knowledgeable about a range of strategies that support ongoing positive interactions with children and families.

## 7. Spend some time familiarizing yourself with the CPL Resources online

These are the three components of the CPL.

Each component leads to the next step.



## 8. Start a CPL working group with your colleagues.

- You could meet once a month at lunch time or after work.
- You could also make the group one of your CPL goals.



9. Set aside a time when you can work on the required components of the CPL (Self Assessment, Professional Learning Planned, Recording Professional Learning).

- It does take some time to complete the different sections of the CPL but once that is completed, working on your goals is not as time consuming.
